ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY:

The University of Kalyani was established in 1960 with the objective of fulfilling one aspect of this need. Initially a unitary university with the faculties of Arts, Science, Education, and Agriculture, it has grown to have 62 affiliated colleges under its aegis in the districts of Nadia and Murshidabad. Since its inception, the University has attracted students of the region and beyond, as can be seen in the glorious alumni list of the University, comprising of eminent scientists, scholars, artists, sportspersons, and people's representatives. In its early stage of growth, the University was bifurcated in the year 1975, with the Faculty of Agriculture turning into an independent Agricultural University, the Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya in Mohanpur, Nadia. The 80s saw the coming into effect of The Kalyani University Act, 1981, but the University had kept growing with and without it.

During the early 80s, the Department of Biophysics and Biochemistry under the Faculty of Science was opened and the Department of Modern Languages under the Faculty of Arts and Commerce started offering a Certificate Course in the Russian Language. During 1998, it gained the status of an affiliating university with its territorial jurisdiction extended to the districts of Nadia and Murshidabad. In the initial stage, 37 colleges of these two districts which were affiliated with the University of Calcutta got their affiliation under the University of Kalyani. The University initiated its Department of Open and Distance Learning offering 4 PG courses - Bengali, Education, English, and History.

During the last ten years, the University has established the School of Interdisciplinary Studies with 3 new departments - Data Science, Genome Science and Nano Science. It also introduced the department of Food & Nutrition under the Faculty of Science, and departments of Hindi, Sanskrit, and Philosophy under the Faculty of Arts and Commerce. Apart from the different departments and schools the University has a good number of affiliated colleges spread within the districts of Nadia, Murshidabad and North 24 Parganas directed towards catering knowledge and education among youth.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Physical Education, Kalyani University, West Bengal has the unique distinction of being the pioneer, with only two other universities in India, in starting a teaching course in Phy. Edn. in a university department in 1963. Subsequently it again became the pioneer among the Universities of Eastern India in introducing Master's in Physical Education Course followed by Doctoral Programme in 1982. The Department has such objectives as helping students acquire a depth of knowledge in the academic discipline of Physical Education, develop knowledge and management skill for efficient functioning as professional leaders in educational institutions, foster and promote research in Exercise and Health Science, to provide leadership for the development of Physical Education.

Department has started courses with 19 students and the student strength increased to 25 with five women students in 1965. It has been increased to 65 in 1974. With introduction of Physical Education as a compulsory subject in the Secondary Education Curriculum, to meet the huge demand, the University has increased the student strength to 80 including 20 women students in 1977.

The department started B.P.Ed. Course of four semesters under NCTE regulation 2014 from 2015-2017 batch with the intake of 50 students. Similarly, the department has also received NCTE recognition for M.P.Ed. Course with the intake of 40 students from 2015-2017 batch.

The department has been catering quality education in the field of physical education and sports science since its very inception and produced numerous alumni working throughout India and abroad with good reputation. Apart from teaching learning the department is one of the leading institutions so far research in the field of Physical Education and Sports sciences are concerned. Time to time the department organizes conferences, seminars and workshops to enrich the realm of knowledge further.

Keeping in view the leading position of the department and present urge of the faculty for enrichment with the pedagogy in connection the subject Physical Education; the members planned to organize a 2 Day's workshop.

ABOUT THE NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020

Education Policy lays particular emphasis on the development of the creative potential of each individual. It is based on the principle that education must develop not only cognitive capacities - both the 'foundational capacities' of literacy and numeracy and 'higher-order' cognitive capacities, such as critical thinking and problem solving - but also social, ethical, and emotional capacities and dispositions. The rich heritage of ancient and eternal Indian knowledge and thought has been a guiding light for this Policy. The pursuit of knowledge (Jnan), wisdom (Pragyaa), and truth (Satya) was always considered in Indian thought and philosophy as the highest human goal. The aim of education in ancient India was not just the acquisition of knowledge as preparation for life in this world, or life beyond schooling, but for the complete realization and liberation of the self. World-class institutions of ancient India such as Takshashila, Nalanda, Vikramshila, Vallabhi, set the highest standards of multidisciplinary teaching and research and hosted scholars and students from across backgrounds and countries. The Indian education system produced great scholars such as Charaka, Susruta, Aryabhata, Varahamihira, Bhaskaracharya, Brahmagupta, Chanakya, Chakrapani Datta, Madhava, Panini, Patanjali, Nagarjuna, Gautama, Pingala, Sankardev, Maitreyi, Gargi and Thiruvalluvar, among numerous others, who made seminal contributions to world knowledge in diverse fields such as mathematics, astronomy, metallurgy, medical science and surgery, civil engineering, architecture, shipbuilding and navigation, yoga, fine arts, chess, and more. The teacher must be at the centre of the fundamental reforms in the education system. The new education policy must help re-establish teachers, at all levels, as the most respected and essential members of our society, because they truly shape our next generation of citizens. It must do everything to empower teachers and help them to do their job as effectively as possible. The new education policy must help recruit the very best and brightest to enter the teaching profession at all levels, by ensuring livelihood, respect, dignity, and autonomy, while also instilling in the system basic methods of quality control and accountability. The new education policy must provide to all students, irrespective of their place of residence, a quality education system, with particular focus on historically marginalized, disadvantaged, and underrepresented groups. Education is a great leveler and is the best tool for achieving economic and

social mobility, inclusion, and equality. Initiatives must be in place to ensure that all students from such groups, despite inherent obstacles, are provided various targeted opportunities to enter and excel in the educational system. These elements must be incorporated taking into account the local and global needs of the country, and with a respect for and deference to its rich diversity and culture. Instilling knowledge of India and its varied social, cultural, and technological needs, its inimitable artistic, language, and knowledge traditions, and its strong ethics in India's young people is considered critical for purposes of national pride, self-confidence, self-knowledge, cooperation, and integration.

ABOUT THE WORK SHOP

Workshop is an arena of discussion, interaction, sharing of views and ideas, gathering and dissemination of knowledge. So far academic workshop is concerned it provides an opportunity to the students, teachers and scholars to refresh and refurbish with respect to a particular area of study.
